Types of Procedures

- Laser treatments use light to improve your skin.
 They can remove hair, treat scars, and even out skin tone.
- Chemical peels use special chemicals to remove the top layers of your skin. This helps to smooth and improve the look of your skin.
- Injectable treatments can help reduce wrinkles, add volume or improve the look of your skin. Common injectables include Botox and dermal fillers.

Cosmetic procedures are **medical** procedures.

Questions to Ask Before a Cosmetic Procedure

- 1. Who will perform my procedure? Make sure a licensed professional will do the treatment.
- 2. What are the provider's qualifications? Ask about their training and experience.
- 3. **Is this treatment right for me?** Ask if this treatment is safe for your skin type and condition. Board certified dermatologists will customize a treatment plan for you.
- 4. What are the risks? What can go wrong, and how often does it happen?
- 5. What should I expect before / during / after? Ask about the procedure details.
- 6. Are there any side effects? Ask about side effects, like redness, swelling, peeling or scarring.
- 7. How much will it cost? Many med spas and salons offer discount coupons for procedures being done by non-medical staff.

Be careful if the price seems too low. Quality care is important for your safety!
